This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

## What We Learned:



Today, your child learned about Joshua, who the Lord appointed as leader of Israel after the death of Moses. God gave Joshua the big job of leading the people into the promised land. Joshua probably wondered if he could do such a hard job, but God helped Joshua just as He had helped Moses. The Lord will also help us. (Scripture used: Joshua 1:1-11, 16-18)

## Words to Remember:

*(Bible versions used are selected to help young children learn and understand the meaning of scripture.)*



**"Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9b NIV**

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

## Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



If you have not done so already, begin giving your child jobs to do around the house. You may want to begin with simple jobs such as feeding the pets or dusting the furniture but gradually make the tasks a little harder.
